InSight is aligned to the following principles and practices:

- Promoting the skills and abilities of the individual
- Building independence with a focus on employability skills
- Understanding and supporting the person to gain exposure and experience of meaningful employment related activities
- Identification of any supports an individual may need to do their job, including on the job support
- Person centred with an individualised approach

The program combines the medium of horticulture and agriculture to explore social enterprise and capacity building activities in the setting of local Trade Training Centres (Huonville, Sorell and Bridgewater). The program develops life skills, independence, employment and community engagement skills, whilst bridging the gap between leaving school and employment where participants are not yet ready to enter the workforce and do not fit the model of Disability Employment Services (DES).
